*Several years ago a Mrs. McCausland from Florida wrote to King William County asking for proof that a Mary Sutherland Motley had married a William Smith. This marriage took place in King & Queen County around 1860-1861.*

*Because of the fire during the Civil War, King & Queen has no records before 1864; therefore, apparently no proof could be found of this marriage.*

*A few years later I received another letter from Mrs. McCausland stating she had visited a cousin, Mrs. Cooke, in Washington, D.C. who had a bible of the Mill Family.*

*Mrs. Cooke graciously sent me copies of the birth, marriage and death records from this bible. And, because these records have been helpful to so many different families with their genealogy problems, I asked if she would allow this information to be published in our Bulletin. She kindly consented and we do thank her.*
